Subject:- Utilization of Composite School Grant under Samagra Shiksha- instructions thereof.

Composite School Grant, is being sanctioned on an annual basis for Government Schools under the Quality component of Samagra Shiksha scheme as a support for quality improvement. The Annual Composite Grant is directly released into the individual Accounts of the schools by the Directorate of Samagra Shiksha as per the entitlement determined by the enrollment of the school. The entitlement as per the enrollment of the school is given below:-

Category	Description	Amount of Grant
A	Schools with enrollment up to 100	25,000/=
B	Schools with enrollment between 100 to 250	50,000/=
C	Schools with enrollment between 250 to 1000	75,000/=
D	Schools with enrollment more 1000	1,00,000/=

The Grant is being provided as an additional support to every Government School to create conducive learning environment in schools and desirably be utilized on quality interventions aimed at all-round development of the student.

The schools can use these grants flexibly and there is no requirement of any Administrative approval for utilization of these grants by the School Heads and at least 10% of it should be used for Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (Swachhta activities) in schools:

It has been observed that most of Hols fail to utilize the Composite Grants for the purpose these are meant and undertake unfruitful activities having no visible impact on ground.

In view of the above, it is enjoined upon all the Hols to ensure the utilization of Composite Grant released to them on the permissible activities (suggestive list enclosed as annexure "A"). Further, all the Hols shall ensure the availability of drinking water, functional toilets and proper hygiene in the schools.
